

Author Guidelines

Dear Author,

The FLAMINGO GUJARAT – Bulletin of Gujarat Birds is released quarterly by the Bird Conservation Society, Gujarat (BCSG) on the subject of Avian-related research of the Political boundary of Gujarat State and adjoining areas of Union Territories only. This bulletin totally caters to the field of various aspects of avian ecology, including bird and their habitats, ecology, checklist of birding sites, migration patterns study, nesting observations, feeding behavior study, bird conservation stories, community involvement in bird conservation, natural history observations, review article, etc. We publish good articles, semi-scientific observations, and other informative literature.

To contribute, please submit your submission (Full-length article/short note/short birding note) in accordance to the following guidelines:

When a bird species is first mentioned, both the English and scientific name must be given; thus, “Laggar Falcon *Falco jugger*”, thereafter, only the English name, thus, “Laggar Falcon” will suffice. English, Scientific names (Italic) and Birds Classification should follow the South Asia Checklist, or Please refer to “A field guide to the birds of Gujarat. Bird Conservation Society, Gujarat.”

1. Manuscript Format:

- Prepare your manuscript in English.
- Submit your article as a Microsoft Word document.
- Maintain a justified alignment for the entire text.
- Include images in .jpeg format with captions (e.g, Image 1, Image 2).
- Specify latitude and longitude coordinates in the format "27.807°N, 74.094°E."
- Provide the corresponding author's postal address, telephone number, and email address.
- Use Times New Roman font with the following sizes:
- Main title: 12 bold
- Author's name, address and email: 11
- Text (including references, bibliography, etc.): 12
- Section titles (e.g., Introduction, Results, and Discussion): 12 bold
- Caption text below figures/photos: 11
- Contents of tables: 11
- Line spacing: 1.15

2. Submitting Manuscripts:

- Send your manuscript as an email with a cover letter along with all necessary attachment: editor@flamingogujarat.com or devvratsinhji.flamingogujarat@gmail.com

3. Editorial Policy:

- FLAMINGO GUJARAT operates a double-blind review process.
- Submissions will be assessed for suitability by the Editor-in-Chief or members of the Editorial Board.
- If found suitable, manuscripts will be sent to independent reviewers.
- The Editor-in-Chief or Associate Editor makes the final decision on acceptance or rejection.

4. Ethical Guidelines:

- Follow the 'BTO - British Trust for Ornithology' policy on the ethics of ornithological research.
- Ensure compliance with ethical standards.

5. Anti-Plagiarism Policy:

- Strictly avoid plagiarism. Clearly state that your submission is original work.
- Familiarize yourself with the plagiarism policy and adhere to it.

6. Conflict of Interests:

- Disclose any conflicts of interest during submission.
